Pray for Steve Heinrichs, our MC Canada director of Indigenous-Settler <u>Relations.</u> Between August 7-10, he will be on trial for his participation in a prayer witness supporting Indigenous peoples' right to free, prior, and informed consent with respect to the Trans Mountain pipeline expansion. Steve will be pleading "not guilty" and faces the possibility of 7 days in jail (the Crown's initial sentencing position).
